

2010 WHITE BEAR LAKE BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT RULES

MSHSL rules shall apply except as noted below:

1. Games will consist of 14-minute stop time halves. Running time will be used in the **LAST 7 MINUTES OF THE** second half if a team is ahead by 20 or more points. If the score then closes to less than 15 points, then stop time will be utilized.
2. Game time is forfeit time. No grace period. Please be ready to play at least 10 minutes ahead of time in case games are running ahead.
3. Half time will be 5 minutes.
4. 4th Grade and 5th Grade Only – No zone defense of any kind is permitted. This includes full court zone presses, ½ - court zone defenses, ½-court traps, and out-of-bounds zone defenses.
5. 4th Grade and 5C Only – Full court pressing is not allowed at any time during the game.
6. 5B Only – Full court pressing is only allowed in the second half. This must be a man-to-man full court press since zone defenses are not permitted.
7. Full court pressing is not allowed by a team leading by 15 or more points.
8. Three timeouts per game. Timeouts do not carry over for overtime. One additional time out per team for overtime.
9. Bonus shots will be awarded on the 7th team foul and the double bonus will be shot on the 10th team foul per half.
10. The first overtime will be a two minute stop time period and the second overtime will be sudden death.
11. All technical fouls will result in an automatic award of two points and the ball out of bounds at the division line. Any player, coach, or parent receiving two technical fouls will be disqualified for the remainder of the tournament and must leave the premises for the duration of the tournament.
12. No protests are allowed. All disputes will be settled by the referees and tournament officials at the time of the occurrence. We appreciate your cooperation and good sportsmanship.
13. The home team (Top team in bracket play, 1st team listed in round robin play) will provide an official scorekeeper that should be stationed near the clock operator. The home team will have their preference of uniform color. When possible, teams should bring two sets of tops (different colors).
14. Players are allowed to only play on one team.
15. 4th Grade Only – The free throw line will be 3 feet closer to the basket than normal.
